In line with the decision of the Academic Council of Lomonosov Moscow State University and in pursuance of the Order of the Rector Academician V.A.Sadovnichy, the Faculty of Computational Mathematics and Cybernetics, together with the Institute of Information Security Issues of Moscow State University, founded the Scientific Center for Information Security Issues. In high recognition of the results obtained by the Institute over the period of almost 20 years, the Center will retain abbreviation “IISI” in its name.

The purpose of the Center is to unite the efforts of the Moscow University aimed at solving the most important tasks to overcome the challenges and neutralize the threats that emanate from the information space. The Center will become the successor of all the developments carried out during the period of the Institute's activity, while involving, if possible, the entire potential of the Faculty of Computational Mathematics and Cybernetics in the field of computer security.

The Center will rely on the potential of Lomonosov Moscow State University as well as on all established contacts of Moscow State University with its Russian and foreign partners.

Efforts to concentrate activities of the University in breakthrough areas of science are carried out on the initiative of the Rector of Moscow State University, Academician V.A.Sadovnichy, with the approval of the Board of Trustees of Moscow State University and its Chairman, President of the Russian Federation V.V.Putin.
