The **Perfusion Science and Cardiac Nursing Track** is designed to provide registered nurses a high-quality training at master level in the area of Perfusion Science and Cardiac Nursing.

Registered nurses, medical and health practitioners, basic scientists or other interested individuals are welcome to take the following courses as Occasional Students

NURS8260 Perfusion Technology and Techniques

This course develops students' understanding on the perfusion techniques. It includes the basic design and operation of perfusion technology. The advanced technologies related to perfusion science such as myocardial protection techniques, monitoring devices, haemodilution, design of circuitry, management of cardiopulmonary bypass will be discussed.

NURS8272 Advanced Practice in Cardiac Nursing

This course explores comprehensive cardiovascular care for patients with various critical conditions and cardiovascular diseases. The course examines clinical care, including diagnosis, investigations, and optimal management of individuals with common and/or advancing heart diseases. The course also explores the advanced care and treatments of patients throughout the process of cardiac surgery and advanced cardiac intervention.

Semester 2A: January to April 2026
(Monday, 18:00-21:00) [Total 30 Contact Hours]

Certificate of ATTENDANCE and CNE points will be awarded to an occasional student who has attended 80% or above of lectures.

Certificate of COMPLETION and CNE points will be awarded to an occasional student who has attended 80% or above of lectures and satisfied the assessment requirements of the course for a pass grade.

Composition fee: HK\$10,440 per course
