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





1. Pre-enrolment on **UNIVERSITALY** within 30 June 2026 + VISA interview at local Embassy/Consulate (for Non-EU citizens residing abroad)

2. Pre-selection (if available in the **dedicated list of courses**) and registration on **Infostud**. The pre-selection is **mandatory** for non-EU candidates residing abroad, **within 15 May 2026**.

3. For non-EU candidates residing abroad and requiring Visa wishing to enrol in an Italian taught course: certificate of Italian knowledge B2, information in **the dedicated page**

4. **Call for Applications** + entry test (if needed) + ranking (if you have chosen a restricted access programme)

5. Verification of documents

Language requirements and certificates

- For admission in a degree program **taught in Italian** language all non-EU citizens residing abroad and requiring visa must have at least a **B2 level in Italian language** according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- If you choose a course **taught in English**, no prior knowledge of Italian is necessary to enroll in Sapienza but most programs require a **B2 level in English language** according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). You can check the **minimum English language requirements** in the call for applications related to the chosen course or in the [pre-acceptance requirements](#) .



Language requirements and certificates

Renewal of the residence permit

If you are a non-EU citizen, already residing in Italy and already holding a residence permit, you need to ask for its renewal **at least 60 days before the expiry date**.

We remind you that, for University enrolment, only the following permits of stay will be accepted, issued by the **Italian Government**:

- EU residence permit for long-term stay;
- residence permit for subordinate work or for self-employment;
- residence permit for family reasons;
- residence permit for asylum, for subsidiary protection or special reasons;
- residence permit for religious reasons;
- electronic residence document for UK citizens (Art. 50 TEU – Art. 18.4 of the EU-UK Withdrawal Agreement).
- you are a non-EU citizen who has been a legal resident in Italy for at least one year and you hold an Italian upper secondary school qualification that grants access to your chosen degree programme;
- you are a citizen of a non-EU country and you are **enrolled in a degree course in an Italian university**, you hold a valid residence permit for study purposes and you wish to apply for a transfer or a change of program for the following academic year. **ATTENTION: if you are moving to Sapienza from another Italian university, do not withdraw (rinuncia agli studi) from your current university. Doing so will invalidate your residence permit and you will need to start again with the study visa procedure by going back to your Country.
