

Simply locate the CIBC Student Pay secure web portal on uOttawa website and follow these simple steps.

- 1 Access the CIBC Student Pay secure platform through the [uoZone](#)**
Log in to [uoZone](#) from the [Students](#) page.
If you are paying from an international account: under Finances and jobs, select International Payment Options and click CIBC Student Pay.
If you are paying from a Canadian account: under Finances and jobs, select Paying online from a Canadian bank account and click CIBC Student Pay.

- 2 Enter a few details**
Input your total tuition in Canadian dollars and select your home country. You'll see the amount converted to your preferred currency if your payment is coming from outside of Canada.

- 3 Choose your payment method**
Fill in a few details and select from a variety of payment options. Click **SUBMIT** to complete your payment.

- 4 Receive your payment confirmation and/or instructions**

During this 72 hour period (excluding weekends and Canadian statutory holidays), you will not be able to access CIBC Student Pay to obtain further quotes.

² If Bank Wire is selected you'll receive detailed instructions along with a reference code to deliver to your local bank within 72 hours. Your bank then follows the instructions and sends the funds to your school. Students can check the status of their payment online at any time.
