

Penn Anthropology Undergraduate Senior Thesis Author Agreement

Authors have two permission options upon submission of the Undergraduate Senior Thesis. Please mark your chosen option:

(1) Permission to Publish on ScholarlyCommons and Privately Store

Authors give the University of Pennsylvania Department of Anthropology the non-exclusive, irrevocable right to copy, distribute, display, and publish their work on ScholarlyCommons, and to migrate it in the future as needed to keep the content available in accessible, online format. Authors also give the University of Pennsylvania Department of Anthropology permission to store the senior thesis both electronically and in hard copy.

(2) Permission to Privately Store Only

Authors give the University of Pennsylvania Department of Anthropology permission to store the senior thesis both electronically and in hard copy. The University of Pennsylvania Department of Anthropology will not distribute or digitally publish the author's work in any way.

Regardless of the permission option chosen, authors retain all copyrights, allowing them to publish, present, and/or use any or all of the material in their contributions for their own purposes. prior or subsequent to the appearance of their work on the University of Pennsylvania ScholarlyCommons site. Authors should be aware that some journals may require exclusive rights to publish research, and they are advised to investigate the conditions imposed by any other journals in which they may wish to publish.
