Change to 77 Bank Policy on Foreign Remittances

Due to tightened international regulations meant to prevent money laundering and terrorist funding, 77 Bank's handling of foreign remittances has changed.

When a foreign citizen uses a 77 Bank account to receive a foreign remittance, you must go in person to the branch where that account is based and present the documents indicated below.

After that, each time you renew your Residence Card or Student (Staff) ID, you must present your new card/ID at the bank.

Materials for verifying the purpose of the remittance (Scholarship notice etc.) If you are receiving a stipend from abroad, bring boarding fee bill, apartment lease agreement, etc. If you do not have a bill, bring any materials you received on tuition/dorm fee payment by direct debit, and explain the situation yourself.	It is preferable that you bring this.
