## Core Skills in Minimally Invasive Surgery Course

This intensive course covers the core laparoscopic surgery skills and knowledge essential for every surgical discipline. A range of high quality laparoscopic equipment were used with specifically designed bench top models as well as learning of variety of knotting and suturing techniques



## Intensive Abdominal Ultrasound Course

15-16 November, 2019

The course introduced fundamental Sonography Theory including terminology and equipment. It provided a study of the clinical applications of Abdominal Sonography, including positioning and scanning protocol. Specific pathology and clinical symptomatology was covered as they relate to the sonographic appearance of these structures. Interpretation and critique of normal and abnormal anatomy with correlation of clinical, didactic and image information was presented.
