

How to access your email on Samsung phone or tablet


- 1- Make sure that you are connected to Wi-Fi or 3G
- 2- Go to settings:




- 3- Go to Accounts and click on Add account:




- 4- Choose Microsoft Exchange ActiveSync:




5- Type your Email & Password and click next:






