**Call for Applications for the Double Degree Master Program with  
Université Paris Dauphine-PSL 2026/27  
for students  
of the “Master of Science in Money, Macro and Finance” (MMF) only**

The Faculty of Economics and Business offers a Double Degree Master Program with the partner university Paris Dauphine-PSL. Students of the MMF are very welcome to apply for the prestigious program. After successful completion of the study program in Frankfurt and Paris you obtain two degrees, the “Master of Science in Money and Finance” from Goethe University and the Master “Economie et Finance” from Université Paris Dauphine-PSL.

The Double Degree Master Program is scheduled for four semesters. In your first and second semester you will follow the study program of MMF in Frankfurt. You will then spend your third semester (winter semester 2026/27) at the University Paris Dauphine-PSL in the Master "Economie et Finance" (30 CP). You can start an internship in January 2027 already and write an internship report (6 CP). Thereafter you prepare your Master thesis either at University Paris Dauphine-PSL or at the Faculty in Frankfurt. (24 CP) in both cases according to the examination regulations of the Faculty of Economics and Business.

There are 5 slots for the Double Degree Master Program.

**Funding:**

The Erasmus+ program provides partial funding. The funding in 2025/26 was 600 Euros per month. The rates for 2026/27 will only be published in summer 2026 on [this](#) website.

**Eligibility:**

- Students in the Master program “Master of Science in Money, Macro and Finance” who started their studies in winter semester 2025/26 and who will be in their 3<sup>rd</sup> semester in winter semester 2026/27.

**Requirements for Participation:**

- Adequate language proficiency (Since the MMF program is taught in English, a certificate proving language competence in English is not mandatory).
- To be ultimately admitted to the programme you have to successfully finish the following modules:
  1. In semester 1: 30 CP consisting of the obligatory modules “Fundamentals of Microeconomics” (6 CP), “Fundamentals of Macroeconomics” (6 CP), “Fundamentals of Econometrics” (6 CP), “Capital Markets and Asset Pricing” (6 CP), “Finance” (6 CP).
  2. In semester 2: 30 CP consisting of 1 module & 1 seminar in “Monetary Economics and Macroeconomics” (12 CP - each 6 CP), 1 module & 1 seminar in “Finance” (12 CP – each 6 CP) and 2 modules in “Supplementaries” (6 CP – each 3 CP)!

## Before the Application

You may apply for the Double Degree Master Program, the QTEM Program and the regular one-semester exchange programs (Erasmus+ and worldwide) simultaneously. If so, please, refer to the corresponding (separate) call for application and use the specific application form of the program.

If you apply simultaneously for the Double Degree Master Program and the QTEM Program please indicate your priority between both programs on the application form. Also, please note that the application for the Double Degree Master Program and the QTEM Program have priority over the regular exchange programs (Erasmus+ and worldwide).

If your application for the Double Degree Master Program or the QTEM program is successful, you will not be admitted to the regular one-semester exchange program (Erasmus+ or worldwide).

## Application Procedure and Required Documents:

1. Please apply [online](#) for the Erasmus+ Program 2026/27 on the Global Office's website [here](#) and upload the required documents (The Mobility Online Portal for 2026/27 will be open from approx. December 20). This step is a prerequisite for participating in the Erasmus+ Program and obligatory for your application. Please indicate on the online application form that you apply for the Double Degree Master Program and, if applicable, name the other university (universities) you choose for the regular Erasmus+ exchange. You will receive a confirmation of receipt of your application. **Please do not use the following e-mail addresses: "icloud", "hotmail", "outlook" or "live".** Problems when sending out messages to these addresses have occurred in the past.
  - Online-Application Form Global Office, so called „**Bewerbungsformular Studierende Outgoing**“, which will be generated when you apply online for the Erasmus+ Program.
  - **In addition Application Form** Double Degree Master Programm 2026/27.
  - **Letter of Motivation** in English stating in detail the reasons for your motivation to participate in the Double Degree Master Program (approx. 1.5 pages/4,500 characters without spaces).
  - **CV** in English.
  - Copy of the **Bachelor Degree Certificate** including the transcript of records.
  - **Information on Registered Exams** (QIS proof) for winter term 2025/26.
  - **Language Certificate**: Not mandatory for English, French B1 recommended, not mandatory.
  - If applicable: **Certificate** showing your **voluntary social commitment** for student initiatives at the Faculty/the University or commitment outside the University. The certificate must state the intensity of your commitment (hours per week), the period of your commitment and your function.
  - **Study Certificate** ("*Studienbescheinigung*" showing the "*Fachsemester*") for winter term 2025/26.

### Please note:

If your application documents are incomplete or if you have not delivered them in time this will lead to the rejection of your application. It is not possible to send additional documents after the application deadline.

**The proportion of female students among applicants is usually lower and we would like to especially encourage female students to apply.**

**Application deadline: 1 February 2026**

**Selection Criteria:**

The selection is based on the application documents:

- Grades of your Bachelor Degree (70%)
- Voluntary social commitment at Goethe University or outside academia, overall quality of application, letter of motivation (30%).
