

- Self-organized semester abroad (Freemover)

## Double Degree Program at Paris Dauphine for MMF students

- 1 or 2 semesters at Dauphine (at least 36 CP at Dauphine)
- B1 french recommended
- Prerequisites:  
Sem 1: 30 ECTS Obligatory Modules  
Sem 2: 30 ECTS: 1 modules & 1 seminar in „Monetary Economics and Macroeconomics“ (6 CP each), 1 module in Finance & 1 seminar in „Finance“ ( 6 CP each and 2 Supplementaries (3 CP each)

- For application: GMAT score of 555 minimum (focus version) or equivalent GRE required (<https://gretogmat.com/>).

# How to apply for the regular exchange at the Faculty

- **Deadline 1 February 2026**
- Application form (4 preferences)
- Bachelor`s degree (70%)
- CV and letter of motivation (up to 4,500 characters excluding spaces) (15%)
- Proof of extracurricular (social) activities (15%)
- Language certificate (according to requirement of partner university)
- Confirmation of enrollment certificate (Studienbescheinigung)
- In addition: Online application (link for application 26/27 will be opened in December) via Global Office when applying for Erasmus universities!

# How to apply for the Double Degree Program (MMF students only)

- **Deadline 1 February 2026**
- Application form double degree
- Bachelor`s degree (70%)
- CV and letter of motivation (up to 4,500 characters excluding spaces) (15%)
- Proof of extracurricular (social) activities (15%)
- Language certificate not mandatory, french B1 recommended
- Confirmation of enrollment certificate (Studienbescheinigung)
- In addition: Online application via Central International Office when applying for Erasmus universities!

# How to apply for QTEM

- **Deadline 01 February 2026**
- Bachelor`s degree (65%)
- GMAT of 555 (focus score) or GRE equivalent (15%)
- Check the [official conversion tool](#)
- Proof of extracurricular (social) activities (5%)
- CV and letter of motivation (up to 4,500 letters excluding spaces) and if available Work certificates and letters of recommendation (15%)
- Erasmus Application will be done after the acceptance to the QTEM network.

## Number of universities on application form

- Regular exchange programmes: you can choose up to four universities
- QTEM: you have to choose five universities



## Application for several exchange programmes

- Multiple applications are possible (University wide exchange, QTEM/ Double Degree, regular exchange programmes)
- In case of multiple successful applications:  
Double Degree/QTEM > regular exchange programmes faculty > exchange programs central international office.

## 6. Freemovers: What to consider?

- Different application procedures and application deadlines
- Tuition fees!
- The host universities must be recognised by the KMK:  
<http://anabin.kmk.org/> (H+ classification)
- Recommendation: Accreditation like AACSB, EQUIS, AMBA
- Rankings might provide orientation
- Alternatives: Summer/Winter Schools, IO website, discounts for students from partner universities <https://www.uni-frankfurt.de/44387799/Summer-Universities>



# 7. Funding

- **Erasmus+**: 540-600 Euros  
(Automatically granted when getting an acceptance to an European University exchange.)
- **DAAD/PROMOS**: 350-550 Euros + travel allowance  
(contact Luisa Döhner for further information)
- „Auslandsbafög“: grant for tuition fees (up to 4,600 Euros)
- **Scholarship Website Goethe Uni**
- There is also Erasmus/PROMOS funding for internships
- There is the option of PROMOS funding for winter/summer schools

# 8. Transfer of Credits

- Learning Agreement (contact examination office for recognition and table B first)
- No obligation to transfer credit points
- Transfer policy: All or nothing!
- Early planning!

# 9. Organisational Issues

- Commitment: Students have to study at partner universities once nominated!
- Change of your choice of partner institution after application at the Faculty is not possible!
- Deadlines: Students are responsible for respecting deadlines (admission at partner universities, scholarships, housing)



# 9. Organisational Issues

- Leave of absence (Urlaubssemester): If your semester abroads ends in December or Januar and you want to take exams at GU in February or March you have to be enrolled as a regular student!
- Knowledge of host country: Do research on the educational system of your host country, cultural habits, housing, living costs, transport, insurance etc. Check the information provided by our partner universities!
- Housing organisation
- Further improve your language skills



# 9. Organisational Issues

## Competencies:

- International Office at Faculty of Economics and Business (Auslandsbüro) : Application procedures, student reports, feedback on partner universities.
- International Office at GU: Scholarships (Erasmus+, PROMOS)
- Transfer of credits: examination office (Prüfungsamt)
- Information about your study program: program coordinators
- Registration, housing, courses, exams: Partner universities
- Be aware of competencies! Do not e-mail everyone you know
