### *New CIHR Opportunities*

[Notice of Upcoming Opportunity](#): Team Grant – GACD 2026: Implementation science to tackle non-communicable diseases. Anticipated launch: March 2026; letter of intent deadline: June 2026; Application deadline Late October/early November 2026. Value: \$200,000 per year for up to five years. While focus is on LMICs, the focus may also be on underserved populations, including Indigenous populations, in high-income countries.

Operating Grant: [European Partnership for Brain Health](#). **Pre-proposal deadline: April 10, 2026; full proposal to European Partnership: June 30, 2026; abbreviated application to CIHR: July 7, 2027.** Value: \$111,000 per year for up to three years (maximum \$333,000). Proposals should address how biological, social and environmental factors affect the trajectory of neurodegenerative disorders across the lifespan.

## *New SSHRC Opportunities*

Notice of Upcoming Opportunity: 2026 [International Joint Initiative for Research Harnessing](#) Disruptive Technologies to Address Global Challenges – focusing on the SDGs, which include health and wellbeing. Launch anticipated in winter 2026; no funding amounts announced yet. This is an interdisciplinary and international program.

[Partnership Engage Grants](#): The next competition is March 16, 2026. Note that U of T researchers must meet internal deadlines, approximately one week before (approx. March 9, 2026). New value: \$10,000 - \$50,000 over one year for short-term partnered research activities. No matching funds required.

### *Competitions with no fixed deadline*

[NSERC and Mitacs](#) have developed a joint application process for researchers seeking support from both agencies. It is now possible to request support through Mitacs Accelerate internships as part of the full Alliance application.

NSERC Alliance Grants. **Application deadline: No fixed date.** There are two streams: Alliance [Advantage](#): \$20,000 to \$1 million per year for 1-5 years, university researchers collaborate with external organizations to meet partner goals. Alliance [Society](#): \$20,000-\$500,000 per year for 1-5 years; university researchers collaborate with partners on projects with societal impact. Beginning December 1, 2025, the [Public Value Impact Proposition Selection Committee](#) will be expanded and will not only assess applications for fit, but will also provide funding recommendations following merit assessment of each application.

[Mitacs Accelerate](#) accepts applications throughout the year. The competition is open to doctoral students and post-doctoral fellows. Students partner with a supervising professor and a partner organization to develop a research project. Partner funding is required. Funding begins at \$15,000 for 8 months.

[Mitacs Elevate](#) accepts proposals all year round. This is a postdoctoral fellowship with a professional development curriculum component. Value: minimum \$55,000 stipend (partner contributes \$30,000 per year).

The [Gateway Foundation for Cancer Research](#) accepts grants from researchers around the world on a rolling basis. Successful grant applications are typically funded within 3 to 4 months. A letter of intent is required, and if accepted, applicants have roughly four weeks to submit the full application.

The [Rising Tide Foundation for Clinical Cancer Research](#) (Switzerland) accepts letters of intent year-round. Note – matching cash funds are required. Check for eligibility by emailing [grants@risingtide-foundation.org](mailto:grants@risingtide-foundation.org) before beginning an application.

The [Mayday Fund](#) offers grants for research into pain. **There is no deadline; grants are reviewed at the next Trustee's meeting.**

[Max Bell Foundation](#) has an ongoing review of grant applications in health and wellness. An LOI is required, and full application is by invitation.

The [R. Howard Webster Foundation](#) (Canada) offers funding in the broad areas of Arts & Culture, Education, Environment, Medical, and Social Services. There are no specific deadlines, and once submitted, review and decision process may take up to 6 months.

[CANSSI Ontario](#) offers grants of up to \$5,000 to cover covers associated with accessing and working with large data sources. Canssi also offers two grants of up to \$10,000 each to support projects using ICES data.

**Applications are accepted on a rolling basis** until two grants have been funded in a given academic year.

**Trainees or faculty members** at Ontario-based universities are eligible to apply. Each proposal must include two faculty members from different academic units (at least one from a stats/biostats department). CANSSI also offers funds (\$500-\$1,000) to support Ontario workshop/lecture programs in emerging areas of statistical and data sciences.

Open Call: the Global Institute of Psychosocial, Palliative & End-of-Life Care has an [open call for fellows](#). This is an unfunded **trainee position**. Eligible candidates: doctorate or medical specialist or a supervisor affiliated with GIPPEC.

The [Thrasher Foundation](#) in the US supports children's medical research. [Early Career awards](#) focus on development of researchers in child health. The competition is open to physicians or **post-doctoral researchers**. **Concept submission deadlines: May 17, 2026, and September 1, 2026**. Maximum funding: \$25,000 in direct costs, for up to two years; indirect costs of no more than 7% of direct costs are allowed. Up to \$12,500 in total may be used for salary of the new researcher.

The University of Toronto's Data Sciences Institute [Doctoral Student Fellowship](#) **application deadline is January 23, 2026**. Value: \$25,000 per year for up to three years. Applicants' research must have a data sciences focus, through development of novel methodology or innovative application of existing approaches. [The Postdoctoral Fellowship](#) **also has a deadline of January 23, 2026**. Value: \$63,000 and up to \$7,000 towards benefits for one year.

The [Centre for Graduate Professional Development](#) Healthy Research Teams and Labs is offering seed funding. **Application deadline is January 23, 2026**. The grant funds initiatives that support development and delivery of grassroots efforts to enhance the experience of working in research teams at U of T. value: \$5,000 maximum for one year.

The [Connaught PhDs for Public Impact Fellowship Program](#) **application deadline is January 29, 2026**. Value: \$12,500 for one year – of this, \$10,000 is a top-up to the student funding package and \$2,500 is for project expenses and/or professional development. **Eligibility: PHD/SJD registered throughout 2026-2027**, in good academic standing, and have completed at least the first year of their program at time of application.

The [Ted Rogers Transform HF Collaboration Grant](#) **application deadline is February 1, 2026**. Maximum per grant: \$10,000 for one year. Three categories, all in support of new partners and early-stage projects: proposal development, collaborative project activities or Knowledge Keeper compensation; preliminary project research and data collection; research proposal writing and editing.

The [Canadian Pain Society postdoctoral fellowship](#) for Canadian Veterans with Chronic Pain **application deadline is February 2, 2026**. Value: \$70,000 for one year.

[AMS Healthcare Small Grant in Compassion](#) and artificial intelligence **application deadline is February 10, 2026**.

Value: \$30,000.

The [Canadian Heart and Stroke Foundation Personnel Awards for Black Scholars](#) **application deadline is February 12, 2026, at 3 pm eastern.** These awards are open to Master's and **Doctoral students** who identify as black and who are studying in an area specific to heart or brain health. Value: \$120,000 (i.e., \$40,000 per year for a maximum of three years); salary support only.

The [Swedish Childhood Cancer Fund](#) is calling for proposals for postdoctoral fellowships for childhood cancer research. This competition is open to international applicants if they intent o pursue a postdoctoral fellowship in Sweden (two years; value: 500,000 Swedish Krone). **Application deadline is February 2, 2026.**

## *CIHR Grant Opportunities*

[Health System Impact Embedded Early Career Researcher](#). **Application deadline February 4, 2026.** This competition supports ECRs in establishing a career pathway with a university and partner organization. Eligibility: early career researcher who is an independent researcher with a faculty appointment at a Canadian university by application deadline (**open to PhDs** who will have graduated and been appointed to a tenure-stream position by February 4, 2026). Open to all citizenship (Canadian, PR, other country). Matching funds required (1-1) from host organization. Salary of up to a maximum of 70% including benefits or \$70,000 per year for four years from CIHR. Research and professional development allowance (minimum of 30% or \$30,000).

The [CIHR Early Reviewer in Training Program](#) will launch January 7, 2026, with an **application deadline of February 4, 2026.** There are two streams: Mentees, who write practice reviews on up to three applications; and ECR reviewers, who review up to five applications. In addition to a CIHR Biosketch, applicants will need a letter from a CIHR eligible institution attesting you are eligible to participate as an ECR.

Operating Grant: [Advancing 2S/LGBTQI+ health through research](#). **Registration deadline February 11, 2026, with full application due March 19, 2026.** This grant will advance research to address health needs, inequities and strengths of the community, broaden and strengthen engagement in 2S/LGBTQI+ health research, strengthen research and community capacity, and support knowledge mobilization strategies.

[Team Grant: Beyond treatment – advancing cancer survivorship](#). **Registration deadline: February 24, 2026; full application due May 20, 2026.** The objectives of this funding opportunity are to advance understanding risks and developments of late and long-term toxicities and complications, and identify strategies to improve survivorship care (re: host, lifestyle, environmental, social and other intersectional factors), foster and enable interdisciplinary team science, bridge the gap between research and practice, and strengthen research capacity in the field. Research areas include breast cancer survivorship, Indigenous peoples' health, pediatric cancer survivorship, reproductive and sexual health in breast cancer survivorship, and more. Funds available: \$18,000,000, enough to fund approximately nine team grants. Maximum per grant is \$400,000 per year for up to five years for a total of \$2,000,000 per grant.

[Team Grant: Healthy Youth \(2025\)](#). **Registration deadline April 28, 2026, with full application due June 16, 2026.** Key design elements: Leadership (independent researcher, KU, youth with lived/living experience); youth engagement; intersectoral and multi-disciplinary teams; equity, diversity and inclusion; Indigenous rights; building and/or bridging capacity; knowledge mobilization. Applications must address at least two of the six priorities in Canada's youth policy and be relevant to IHDCYH's Empowered Youth Area of Focus. Also, research focus is on: First Nations, Inuit or Metis Youth Health; Youth Health in Equity-Denied Communities; Circulatory and Respiratory Health in Youth; Type 1 Diabetes and Psychosocial Health in Youth. Funding available: \$10,500,000 enough to fund approximately seven team grants. Maximum amount per year: \$1,500,000 over five years. **There will be an information webinar Thursday, January 29, 2026, at 12:00 PM ET | [Join](#).**

[CIHR Research Excellence, Diversity, and Independence \(REDI\)](#) early career transition award 2025. **Application deadline is June 16, 2026.** This two-phase program will support trainees from underrepresented groups. Awards begin seeking an independent research position during mentored Phase 1 and are expected to transition to this position in Phase 2, within 3 years of the funding start date. Stream A is for trainees who self-identify as Black (any gender), racialized women, or racialized gender-diverse people; Stream B is for trainees who self-identify as First Nations, Inuit, Métis (any gender). Trainees must be one of a PhD holding postdoctoral researcher; a clinician (MD, DVM, DDS) or PhD holding allied health professional in either postdoctoral or faculty position (non-research) or a RA or equivalent who holds a PhD at a CIHR eligible institution. Funds available: \$34,500,000, enough to fund approximately 50 awards and 50 community engagement and knowledge mobilization supplements. Maximum amount per award is anticipated to be \$90,000 per year for up to three years (\$70,000 per year for the stipend, \$20,000 per year for the research allowance); and followed by \$120,000 per year for up to three years. \$1,500,000 is available in the KM supplementary funding; each applicant can receive up to \$5,000 per year in additional funding for up to six years. **Info session #2 late January 2026; Q& A session for applicants March 2026.**

## **Research Updates**

### *Tri-Agency Updates*

#### **2025-12-23. Important update: Transitioning away from the Canadian Common CV (CCV)**

The granting councils are in the process of gradually shifting toward a new narrative-style CV for all funding competitions. As this transition progresses, the use of the CCV will be phased out.

**What does this mean for the granting councils (CIHR, NSERC, and SSHRC)?**

The granting councils will continue to use the CCV for select funding opportunities as they gradually transition to a new narrative-style CV format. This shift will be implemented over time, and users will be supported throughout the process.

**What does this mean for partner organizations?**

As part of this transition, **all partner organizations will end their use of the CCV by March 31, 2026**, at the latest.
