

# Evaluation criteria for applications concerning the Master track of Landscape Architecture, intake 2026-2028

Portfolio and Letter of Motivation give the following profile of the applicant:

- **Convincing motivation:** Your application demonstrates an explicit interest in the Landscape Architecture MSc program and presents convincing reasons for choosing the program at TU Delft.
- **Effective communication:** Your application demonstrates the ability to describe and communicate a variety of topics concisely and originally and to express ideas effectively using different visual tools (e.g. mapping, hand and digital drawings, diagrams, photos).
- **Disciplinary insight:** Your application demonstrates an understanding of landscape architecture and its relation to architecture and urbanism. It illustrates your development as a designer from your first-year projects to your final-year projects.
- **Academic approach:** Your application demonstrates a systematic, step-by-step approach and shows to what extent the design process was informed by research, evidence and verification.
- **Site-specific design skills:** Your application demonstrates your design skills in relation to the physical context from first analysis to the final proposal.

All criteria must be met. Failing on one of them can lead to a rejection.
