





The Online Course Catalogue

The online course catalogue is available at <http://lsf.verwaltung.uni-muenchen.de/>. You can switch to a partially English surface by clicking on “English version” in the upper right-hand corner. There, you can also choose the semester you would like to check for classes. You can use the catalogue without having a username and password.

1. Checking the course offerings of a department

Choose “course catalogue” and then click on the department you are interested in:





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Within a department, you will find various fields of study. In this example, you can see that “Social Sciences” subsumes 1) Politics, 2) Sociology and 3) Communication Science.

This course will focus on the development and stability of democracy in Germany. It will begin with an overview of democracy, democratisation, and democratic stability before examining the historical drivers of democratic development and stability in Germany. This will include comparisons to the development and stability of democracy in other major developed democracies. In doing so we will apply different democratisation theories to the German context and examine the question of how well democratic development in Germany fits with different theories of democratisation and democratic stability.



2. Checking for courses taught in English

Click on “search for courses”. This will open the search function.

You cannot, unfortunately, check a full academic year. Either you select one semester or all the semesters currently available in the online course catalogue. Also select the desired “language of instruction”, and your preferred “department”. Make sure that “type of lecture” is set at “select all” and make sure not to select “curricula”. Otherwise, your search will not produce particularly useful results.

As mentioned above, the field “exchange students” is still in a pilot phase and therefore only used to a limited extent.



To select the department, click on the department you are interested in and, if available and appropriate, the sub-department and individual chairs. Unless you need to choose very specific classes, it is not advisable to go beyond the second level (i.e. sub-departments) since this will inevitably reduce the number of hits you obtain.

The latter choice only makes sense if you are searching on the level of individual chairs.
