Profile

Yul Sohn is Professor of the Graduate School of International Studies (GSIS) and Underwood International College(UIC) at Yonsei University, Seoul, Korea. He served as the President of the East Asia Institute (EAI), a premier foreign policy think-tank in South Korea (2018-2025). Sohn also served as Dean of the GSIS (2012-2016), President of the Korean Association of International Studies (2019) and the Association for Contemporary Japanese Studies (2012). Sohn currently consults the ROK government agencies as a policy advisor, including the Presidential Office of National Security and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Before joining the faculty at Yonsei, Sohn taught at the University of Tokyo and Chung-Ang University, and was a visiting scholar at institutions in the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, and the University of California, Berkeley. He was Senior Fellow of the Fulbright Foundation, MacArthur Foundation, Japan Foundation and Waseda University's Institute for Advanced Studies. Sohn has written extensively on East Asian international relations, Japanese and East Asian political economy, and public diplomacy.

Sohn received his Ph. D. in Political Science from the University of Chicago, Illinois, USA.
