Selection cut-off criteria for master's programs in winter semester 2023/2024

Dear prospective students,

The second page of this communication provides information on selection cut-off criteria for the **quota of places allocated on the basis of the selection procedure** (80% of available master's study places) as well as for the **quota of places allocated on the basis of waiting periods** (20% of available master's study places).

The data provided always refers to the last person to be awarded a place in a master's program within the respective allocation quota.

Cut-off criteria always refer to past semesters. It is not possible to predict cut-off criteria for coming semesters, as these can only be calculated once an admission procedure is complete.

Selection cut-off criteria for master's programs apply to all applicants who meet the subject-specific admission requirements for a program.

The selection procedure results in an overall score calculated on the basis of the points awarded for individual selection criteria.

Key:

Pts: points awarded as part of the selection procedure
 WP: waiting period
 P: priority in case of equal ranking
 S: selected admission, see example 1

Examples:

1. Places awarded according to qualifications: e.g. 54.0 pts. / 00 WP S

All applicants were admitted who achieved a score of more than 54.0 points (out of 100) in the selection procedure for the program.

All applicants with a score of 54 points were also admitted if they were able to demonstrate a waiting period of more than 1 semester.

Only some applicants with 54 points and no waiting period were admitted. Places for these applicants were allocated by drawing lots.

2. Allocation according to waiting time: e.g. 2 WP

All applicants were admitted who had completed a waiting period of at least 2 semesters or more.

3. All applicants admitted

All applicants meeting the subject-specific admission requirements were admitted.
