Thank you for your interest in the Aggie ACHIEVE inclusive postsecondary education program at Texas A&M University! **Aggie ACHIEVE (Academic Courses in Higher Inclusive Education and Vocational Experiences)** is a comprehensive transition program (CTP) for young adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) who have exited high school. Aggie ACHIEVE aligns coursework, internship opportunities, and extracurricular activities with each student's academic interests and employment goals through an inclusive, immersive college experience to equip students for employment in the community. Aggie ACHIEVE is designed to enroll students for up to four years; students completing the program will earn a Certificate of Interdisciplinary Studies from the School of Education and Human Development. Aggie ACHIEVE students reside in Texas A&M residence halls for the first two years of the program and move to off-campus housing for the third and fourth years. We are now accepting applications for our next cohort of students for the 2023-2024 academic year beginning in August 2024.
