

Additional Transfer Requirements

- Effective Fall 2025 applicants must pass an audition with Music Program Faculty in addition to meeting the academic preferences for transfer consideration into the Music Performance program. Audition information is available from the [Undergraduate Academic Advisor](#)
- Transfer applicants should have completed 15 hours of coursework.
- Students should strive to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater on all college courses that transfer to TAMU.
- The Music Performance program is looking for students who are interested in pursuing our degree as a focus. Students should indicate our program as the primary major they are interested in if they wish to be admitted. The audition documents and supporting materials should reflect that the student is interested in pursuing our degree.
- Meeting minimum requirements **does not** guarantee admission. The entire record is reviewed for consistency in coursework and grades.
- Student may transfer only 2 credit hours of Individual Performance Instruction and 2 credit hours of Ensemble Performance. The remaining requirements of 4 credit hours of Individual Performance Instruction and 4 credit hours of Ensemble Performance must be completed within the Texas A&M Music Performance Program.
