Study Abroad Programs



UC Education Abroad Program (UCEAP)

What is it?

- UCEAP programs offer UC credit, grades, and financial aid. Program options include immersion, special focus study, language & culture, internships, and research
 - 40+ Countries, 100+ International Partner Universities, and 400+ program options

When?

- Summer, Quarter, Semester (Fall OR Winter/Spring), and Year-Long program options

Budget?

- All program expenses including tuition, room/board, round trip airfare, mandatory health insurance incidentals, local transportation, visa fees, onsite orientation, etc.

Financial Aid?

- Eligible for up to the same funding received at UCSD (Federal, State, and UC Aid) and potentially an additional \$2,000 in UC Grant for those that qualify

Billing?

- Administered by the UCEAP Office in Santa Barbara. UCSD Financial Aid office first packages your aid and commits/reports it to UCEAP. All disbursements, payments, and direct deposit is done through the UCEAP portal

UCSD Global Exchange

What is it?

- Reciprocal, study abroad opportunities between UC San Diego and partner universities.
- Approximately 11 Programs across 7 Countries (varies every year)

When?

- Semester (Fall OR Winter/Spring), and Year-Long program options

Budget?

- All program expenses including UCSD tuition, room/board, round trip airfare, mandatory health insurance incidentals, local transportation, visa fees, onsite orientation, etc.

Financial Aid?

- Eligible for up to the same funding received at UCSD (Federal, State, and UC Aid)
- UCSD students that participate in Global Exchange are regularly enrolled at UCSD, pay regular tuition and fees, and have access to their usual financial aid

Billing?

- Administered by UCSD. Student makes payments and receives disbursements through UCSD

UCSD Global Seminars

What is it?

- Summer session global experiences led by a UCSD professor. Students enroll in a package of two courses for a total of 8 UCSD quarter units and 15-28 students per class
 - Approximately 27 Programs (varies every year)

When?

- Summer only

Budget?

- Budgets include almost everything including program fees, UCSD tuition and fees, housing, airfare, etc.. Personal expenses are not included

Financial Aid?

- Summer Pell Grant (if pell eligible during prior AY & within lifetime eligibility limits) - amount will depend on summer units
- If Pell eligible & CA Resident, supplemental UCSD Summer Grant is available for approximately \$2,000 for eligible students with financial need and a minimum of 6 units (Subject to annual review of available funding).
- Unused Federal Loans from the academic year will be offered (if eligible)

Billing?

- Administered by UCSD. Student makes payments and receives disbursements through UCSD

Opportunities Abroad Programs

What is it?

- Administered by Non-UC study abroad providers that are affiliated with UCSD. Students earn transfer credit. Courses may be applied towards UCSD major, minor, and/or GE requirements

When?

- Summer, Quarter, Semester (Fall OR Winter/Spring), and Year-Long program options

Budget?

- Budgets will vary, but often include everything except airfare, some meals, and personal expenses

Financial Aid?

- **Federal and State aid only (NO UCSD-based aid)**
- A Consortium Agreement and Academic Planning Form will be required on the Tritons Abroad application

Billing?

- Students receive financial aid disbursement through UCSD and are responsible for paying their host institution or program directly

 - Credit check required (If parent is denied, student can request additional Unsubsidized Loan)
- **Private / Alternative Loan** - (Independent Student)

Off Campus Cost of Attendance **\$44,742** - UCSD Health Fee **\$2,961** = **\$41,781**

Example - Full Year at UCSD

UCSD Budget: Approximately **\$41,781** for the academic year

- Grade Level: 3rd year Dependent / FA23 Cohort

Student Aid Index (SAI): **\$4,446** in this example

Financial Need: **\$41,781 (UCSD Budget) - \$4,446 (SAI) = \$37,335**

Students are offered financial aid up to their financial need
(grants, loans and scholarships)

- If eligible, credit based Parent PLUS Loan will be added up to students budget (for dependent students)
- Alternative credit based private loan will be added up to the students budget (for independent students)

SAI reduces any “need based aid” that is offered

UCEAP Budget: Approximately **\$41,781** for the academic year

- Grade Level: 3rd year Dependent / FA23 Cohort

Student Aid Index (SAI): **\$4,446** in this example

Financial Need: **\$41,781 (UCEAP Budget) - \$4,446 (SAI) = \$37,335**

Students are offered financial aid up to their financial need
(grants, loans and scholarships)

- Students who go abroad the full year will receive 2/3 of their Pell Grant, and all of their Cal Grant (if eligible).
- If eligible, credit based PLUS Loan will be added up to students budget (for dependent students)
- Alternative credit based private loan will be added up to the students budget (for independent students)

Financial Need: **\$20,971 - \$1,482 = \$19,489**

Students are offered financial aid up to their financial need
(grants, loans and scholarships)

- **Pell Grant** (1/3 of Academic Year) = \$984
- **Cal Grant** (1/3 of Academic Year) = \$4,584
- **UCSD Grant** = ~ **\$4,211** (\$2,000 Increase)
- **Subsidized Loan** = \$1,833
- **Unsubsidized Loan** = \$667
- **University Loan** = \$933
- **PLUS Loan** (dependent students) / Alternative Private Loan (independent students) = Up to remaining budget
 - \$6,277 PLUS Loan in this example

UCEAP/Global Exchange: If study abroad program total cost is more than UCSD total cost, eligible students will be considered for up to an additional \$2,000 in UCSD Grant

- **Cal Grant** (1/2 of Academic Year) = \$6,876
- **UCSD Grant** = ~ \$2,653
- **Subsidized Loan** = \$3,667

- **PLUS Loan** (dependent students) / Alternative Private Loan (independent students) = Up to remaining budget

Summer Abroad

Summer Abroad Eligibility

- **Summer Pell Grant** = Depends on Student Aid Index (SAI), Annual Pell used, lifetime eligibility used & units (Enrollment Intensity / Min. 6 units required)
- **UCSD Summer Grant** = ~ \$2,000 (subject to annual funding and student need eligibility)
- **Subsidized & Unsubsidized Loans** = Unused from academic year will be offered, based on annual eligibility
- **Parent PLUS Loan** = Up to remaining summer cost of attendance
 - Credit based loan for dependent students
 - Independent students have the option to apply for credit based Alternative Private Loans
- **Cal Vet Fee Waiver** = Will cover only the UC Summer Tuition & Fees portion of program
- **Cal Grant** = \$0 (Not applicable for summer)
- **University Loan** = \$0 (Not applicable for summer)

Summer vs Academic Year Abroad

Summer

Pell Grant - Amount will depend on enrollment intensity (units) if eligible

UCSD Grant - Approx. ~\$2,000 for pell eligible students with financial need (subject to annual review of funding)

Scholarships

Cal Vet Fee Waiver - Will only cover summer tuition/fees

Loans

- Unused Subsidized & Unsubsidized Loans will be offered
- PLUS loans up to remaining budget will be offered (dependent students)
- Private Alternative Loan (independent students)

Non-Residents - Abroad Comparison

Example: Non-California Resident Tuition = \$32,574

Fall Semester

Non-resident tuition will be $\frac{1}{2}$ (\$16,287) vs. $\frac{1}{3}$ (\$10,858) at UCSD

+\$5,429

Non-Res **Increase** going abroad

Winter/Spring

Non-resident tuition will be $\frac{1}{2}$ (\$16,287) vs. $\frac{2}{3}$ (\$21,716) at UCSD

-\$5,429

Non-Res **Decrease** going abroad

Summer

Non-resident tuition is \$0

Full Year

Non-resident tuition will be similar as attending UCSD

Consider a full year! Costs will be similar, if not the same as at UCSD.


Fall semester at UCEAP/GE will be MORE expensive. Consider a spring semester that overlaps winter and spring quarter at UCSD.

Summer is the perfect time... there is NO non-resident supplemental tuition!


Important FA Deadlines

- For students considering abroad programs for Fall 2026, Winter 2027, Spring 2027, and Summer 2027 programs
- **FAFSA application opens on October 1st, 2025**
- **PRIORITY DEADLINE: March 2nd, 2026**

***NOTE:** Summer 2026 programs will be using current 2025-2026 FAFSA/DREAM application information.

There is no separate application for summer financial aid





Chancellor's Study Abroad Scholarship

The Chancellor's Study Abroad Scholarship will fund up to 50 UC San Diego students annually with awards of up to \$5,000!

Available to all students participating on any UC San Diego program (UCEAP, Global Seminars, Global Exchange) for any length (summer, quarter, semester or year).

Application will open in ~ December 2025 on the [Study Abroad UC San Diego Scholarships Website](#)



UCEAP Scholarships

UCEAP Global Scholarship: All UC students participating in a UCEAP program are eligible to apply. The award selections will be primarily based on academic merit and integration of a selected UCEAP program into a student's academic and career goals, as demonstrated in a personal statement.

- ~\$1,000 each for summer programs; application opens January 15th - February 15th
- ~\$2,000 for quarter, semester, or year study; application opens January 15th - March 15th for fall & year programs / August 15th - September 15 for spring programs
- Additional named awards offered; submit UCEAP Global Scholarship application to be considered (One and done)

Application requires:

- Form (general information)
- Statement of Purpose (~750 words)

UCEAP Year-Long Scholarships

Chris Borton Scholarship

Merit-based Awards

- Amount: \$8,000; 8 awards total...4/8 awards for UCSD students

Eligibility:

- Minimum 3.0 Cumulative GPA
- Students are not required to have financial need to be eligible to apply

Duttenhaver Scholarship

Based on Academic Performance & Financial Need

- Amount: \$5,000 per year; 30+ awards annually
- Duttenhaver extension scholarships (\$2,500) for students extending to year programs

Eligibility:

- Minimum 3.0 Cumulative GPA
- Preference for students with financial need & limited international experience

Application Deadline: March 15th, 2026

Gilman Scholarship

Purpose: Sponsored by the US Dept. Of State, undergraduate scholarship program for US citizens of limited financial means to enable them to study abroad and prepare them to thrive in the global economy.

Award Amount: Up to \$5,000 (\$3,000 for Summer Programs); Potential \$3,000 more for study in a Critical Need Language

Number of Awards: 2,800+ nationally (Approx. 30-40 UCSD recipients annually)

Eligibility:

- Demonstrated Financial Need
- Must be a Pell Grant recipient at time of application or during study abroad
- U.S. Citizen

Application deadline:

- **October 3, 2025** (Spring 2026 - Fall 2026 programs)
- **March 5, 2026** (Summer 2026 - Spring 2027 programs)
