

Other Libraries in Austin

The [Lyndon Baines Johnson Library and Museum](#), located on the eastern edge of the campus, is operated by the National Archives and Records Administration. Though not part of the University library system, this library is a rich resource for scholars studying the twentieth century. Faculty members and students also have access to other public and private libraries in the Austin area, including several that focus on special areas of interest.

The [Nettie Lee Benson Latin American Collection](#) is world-renowned for Latin American materials. The library holds over one million books, periodicals, pamphlets, and newspapers; and over 7,000 linear feet of archives and manuscripts. The collection acquires research material from across Latin America, the Caribbean, and the United States, on Latin Americans and U.S. Latinas/os, with subject focuses including the humanities, social sciences, natural resources, natural sciences, history of medicine, law, human rights, civil rights, technology, and Latina/o Studies. The Benson Collection proudly marked its centennial in 2021.
