

Memo Research in Computer Science

1. Preamble

The “Research in Computer Science” course can be chosen as a free elective course within the Master’s Program in Computer Science. Note that this course is **exclusively** reserved for **students of the Master’s Program in Computer Science**. It is conducted under the supervision of a professor of the department of computer science or an [associated professor](#). Furthermore, in order to be eligible to register for this course, **one** of the following prerequisites must be fulfilled:

- 1 interfocus course and 1 core course (major)
- 2 core courses (major)
- 2 interfocus courses

In addition, students must have earned at least 20 credits in each individual semester **AND** have a GPA of 5.0 in each individual semester of their master’s studies.

2. Registration

- The course has to be registered by the Studies Administration Office, a registration via MyStudies is not possible. Before starting the project, send a registration request with the name of your supervisor and the **task description** to the [Student Administration Office](#). It will be checked if all prerequisites are met and the course will be registered.

3. Submission

The submission of the report is handled between the supervisor and the student.

4. Grading / Repetition

The research in computer science course unit is a graded semester performance. Repetition is only possible after re-enrolling.
