

## Tuition, semester and other fees

(In accordance with the Fee Ordinance for the ETH Domain of 31 May 1995; state 5 December 2024)

The study fees at ETH Zurich include the tuition and the semester fees. The invoice is sent automatically by email.

### 1. Tuition fees per semester

Students Master of Advanced Studies (MAS)
MAS students pay tuition fees for two semesters, plus a contribution to costs as determined by the Executive Board. The total amount is paid in two equal part-payments during the first two semesters, regardless of the total duration of the respective programme.
Students Certificate/Diploma of Advanced Studies (CAS/DAS)
DAS/CAS students pay the tuition fee for one semester and a contribution to costs as determined by the Executive Board. Terms of payment are different for each course.

- with Swiss citizenship
- with Liechtenstein citizenship
- from member states of the European Union, provided they are employees, self-employed or family members of persons are subject to the Agreement on the Free Movement of Persons with the EU (AFMP) resp. EFTA Agreement.
- for children of such persons, provided the children are resident in Switzerland.

<sup>2</sup> Students who establish residence in Switzerland or the Principality of Liechtenstein for the purpose of their studies or who are not resident in either country. Residence is deemed to have been established for the purpose of studies if the person concerned was not resident in either Switzerland or the Principality of Liechtenstein at the time of the university entry qualification certificate was acquired.
