ADMISSION RULES FOR THE LAUREA PROGRAMMES

(eq. to BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES) AY 2025/26

COURSE CHANGES:

Students enrolled in the Laurea Programme (eq to Bachelor Degree Programme) of the School of Design at Politecnico di Milano in Design del Prodotto Industriale, Design della Moda, Design degli Interni, Design della Comunicazione and Interaction Design

The change to another Laurea Programme in Design may occur through:

- a) a merit ranking or
- b) taking the Design Admission Test (TOLD) and obtaining a position suitable for enrolment.

Students enrolled in the Laurea in **Design del Prodotto Industriale, Design della Moda, Design degli Interni, Design della Comunicazione** who apply for a change to the laurea in **Interaction Design**, must submit a valid English language certificate (by the application deadline);

Students of foreign nationality, holding a diploma obtained abroad, enrolled in the Laurea in **Interaction Design** who apply for changing to the Laurea in **Design del Prodotto Industriale, Design della Moda, Design degli Interni, Design della Comunicazione**, must submit a valid B2 level Italian language certificate (by the application deadline);

TRANSFERS:

Students from the Schools of Engineering and Architecture of the Politecnico di Milano:

The transfer to a Laurea Programme in Design may only occur by taking the **Design Admission Test (TOLD)** and **obtaining a position suitable for enrolment**

Students from other Universities:

The transfer may only occur by taking the **Design Admission Test (TOLD)** and **obtaining a position suitable for enrolment** *
